Lastly, please include this cover sheet and a copy of your resume.

Please answer questions 1-3, and limit your total, cumulative response to all these questions to two typed pages (double-spaced).

- Question 2. What is your judicial philosophy?
- Question 3. How will you go about maintaining impartiality in your role as a justice?

Eligibility Policy : (SGA Constitution, Article VII, Sec. 1) - Have at least a 2.00 overall grade point ratio for undergraduate students and at least a 3.00 grade point ratio for graduate students at the time of the election, selection, or appointment. Post at least a 2.00 grade point ratio for undergraduate students and at least a 3.00 grade point ratio for graduate students for the semester prior to the election, selection, or appointment. Post at least a 2.00 grade point ratio for undergraduate students and at least a 3.00 grade point ratio for graduate students for the regular semester during the term of office.

Be in good standing with the University and enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours in a fall or spring academic semester during the term of office. If the student is enrolled in the Blinn TEAM program, they must meet the stipulations outlined in Student Rule 41.2.2.1 or such equivalent student rules governing the Blinn TEAM program.

Students enrolled in the Blinn TEAM program are also eligible to hold office as long as the student is meeting all applicable Blinn TEAM requirements and is in good standing with the program.
