Joseph Boggs vs. Election Commission

In the case of Joseph Boggs vs. Election Commission, the decision that the Election Commissioner made was concurrent with the Texas A&M Election Commission Election Regulations, Article IV, Section I, Subsection (f).

"The winners of all elections must submit the expenditures form and receipts to the Election Commission within forty-eight (48) hours after election results are posted. Candidates with no expenses must still submit a completed expenditures form. Winners not submitting itemized expense reports will be disqualified and removed from office."

Despite efforts to abide by the above regulation (Article IV, Section I, Subsection (f)), Joseph Boggs failed to submit his expenditure form by the specified deadline. After careful deliberation and consideration of the facts presented, the Judicial Court unanimously upholds the decision of Election Commissioner Erin Eckhart to disqualify Joseph Boggs from the Class of 2006 Historian race.
